

Exam Monitoring Requirements

Many states require that you take your final exam in the presence of a monitor. Failure to comply with exam monitoring requirements will invalidate course credit.

The student may not mail his/her exam for processing. The monitor must confirm the identity of an unknown student with a photo ID. *Students in NE must take the exam in a closed book format and student must remain in the room during the entire exam *Students in MA must provide at least two forms of identification to the monitor, with at least one containing a photo of the student.

Arizona, Indiana, Iowa	Licensed Agent
Florida	Principal of accredited elementary or secondary school or professional staff designated by a principal, college instructor, counselor, official military education officer or Chaplain, insurance company home office education representative, qualified representative of a national trade agent or adjuster association or society librarian. Other individuals may be approved as monitors by obtaining approval in advance from the Dept of Insurance. Such individuals cannot be relatives, work supervisor or immediate employers of the examinee. Entity approved in Florida—Broker Educational Sales Training—727-372-7733. Self study paper exams a require monitor. Online exams do not require a monitor.

Only the monitor may return the monitor affidavit and grading registration form.
